This is a collaborative study of the University of Nairobi, the WestVac Biopharma Co., Ltd. and West China Hospital of Sichuan University on Recombinant COVID-19 vaccine (Sf9 cells) to be done at the University of Nairobi's Kenya AIDS Vaccine Initiative Institute of Clinical Research (KAVI-ICR).
